

SOUTH FLORIDA SHOOTING CLUB

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- * KEEP FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN SHOOTING A TARGET IN THE SHOOTING POSITION
- * KEEP GUN POINTED DOWN RANGE AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE SHOOTING STATION. IF YOUR FEET ARE MOVING, YOUR GUN MUST BE UNLOADED, OPEN, EMPTY AND IN BREECH BACK POSITION.
- * LOAD ONLY WHEN YOU ARE IN SHOOTING STATION IN SHOOTING POSITION
- * DO NOT LOAD MORE THAN TWO SHELLS IN THE GUN AT ANY TIME WHILE IN THE SHOOTING STATION
- * EAR AND EYE PROTECTION MUST BE WORN BY ALL SHOOTERS, TRAPPERS AND SPECTATORS AT ALL TIMES ON THE SPORTING COURSE
- * DO NOT SHOOT WILDLIFE ON THE SOUTH FLORIDA SHOOTING CLUB GROUNDS, ALONG WITH SIGNS, TRAPS OR ANY OTHER CLUB PROPERTY.
- * DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MEND, ALTER OR ADJUST TRAPS AT ANY TIME. REPORT TO THE CLUB ANY INFRACTIONS.
- * NO SHOT SIZE LARGER THAN 7 ½ MAX LOAD 32 GRAMS.
- * NO STEEL SHOT ALLOWED
- * ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED ANYWHERE ON THE COURSE AND THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO SHOOTING AFTER ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION.
